With the computed transform **H**, the RGB vector, $\hat{\mathbf{u}} \in \mathbb{R}^{3\times 1}$, corresponding with the given CIEXYZ vector \mathbf{q} under a certain illuminant, is predicted as

$$\hat{\mathbf{u}} \triangleq \mathcal{H}(\mathbf{q}) = \mathbf{H}^{\mathsf{T}} \tilde{\mathbf{q}}. \tag{13}$$

Without loss of generality, suppose that three illuminants, namely, D65, A, and F11, are considered. Accordingly, we obtain three global transforms, represented by $\mathcal{H}_D(\cdot),\,\mathcal{H}_A(\cdot),$ and $\mathcal{H}_F(\cdot)$ for these illuminants, and the RGB candidates are computed as $\hat{\boldsymbol{u}}_{D65}=\mathcal{H}_D(\boldsymbol{q}),\,\hat{\boldsymbol{u}}_A=\mathcal{H}_A(\boldsymbol{q}),\,\hat{\boldsymbol{u}}_{F11}=\mathcal{H}_F(\boldsymbol{q}).$
